KPASCO CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

ARTICLE VII – ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Present – Section 702: The election shall take place the following month with term of office beginning in January.

Proposed: The election shall take place in October with term of office beginning immediately upon tabulation of election results.

Pros:

1. Aligns KPASCO constitution with AFSCME constitution.
2. Creates transition period between incoming and outgoing officers for smoother transfer of office.

Cons:

1. Overlap of officer stipend for up to a 2 month period during transition period.

Present – Section 707: A plurality vote of those votes cast shall elect each Executive Committee member. Results will be posted for the membership and will be kept on file for a period of one year.

Proposed: A majority vote of those votes cast shall elect each Executive Committee member. Results will be posted for the membership and will be kept on file for a period of one year.

Pros:

1. Aligns KPASCO constitution with AFSCME constitution.

Cons:

1. May necessitate a runoff election in the event that no one candidate receives a majority vote.
