Chino Valley Medical Center spends less per hour on their nurses than any other hospital in a twenty mile radius. [See the chart below.](#)

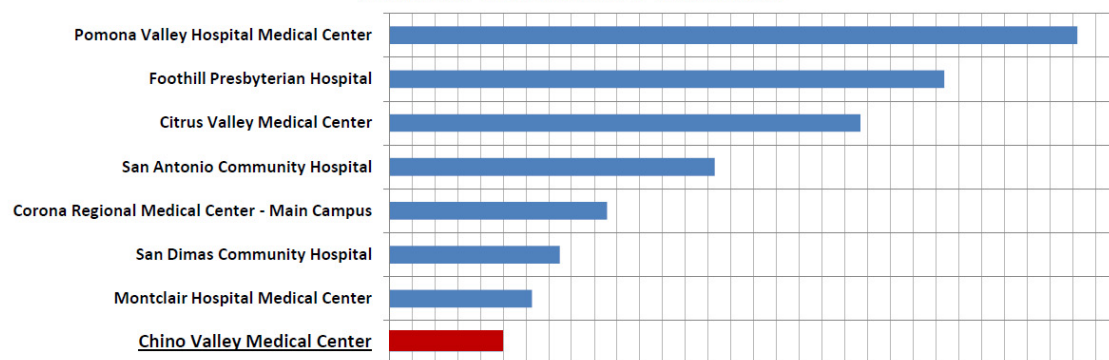
