CLASS DESCRIPTION: What is the significance of an elevated Mean Corpuscular Volume (MCV)? What does an elevated blood urea nitrogen (BUN) level indicate? What is the diagnostic difference between ST depression and ST elevation? How does pregnancy affect normal lab values?
