

NEW TECHNOLOGY LANGUAGE PROTECTS OUR PATIENTS AND OUR PRACTICE CONTRACT EXTENDED UNTIL MARCH 31

The UNAC/UHCP-FVPA bargaining team and Tenet/Fountain Valley Regional Hospital reached agreement on brand new contract language that ensures that your clinical judgment is not replaced or superseded by computer algorithms.

The tentative agreement, which supports the provision of safe, therapeutic and effective care, requires management to meet with the Healthcare Professional Advisory Committee (HPAC) before rolling out any new technology. The language ensures RNs/professionals' input and concerns are heard prior to implementation. It also requires the employer to provide the necessary training to those members affected by technology changes.

We also agreed to another extension of the contract until March 31. The next session is scheduled for March 19 and 20. All members are invited to attend and observe our talks with management.
