Patient Advocacy—Every Nurse's Prime Objective



Today, we won an important voice in patient advocacy for RNs, with an agreement that puts California nurse-to-patient ratios into our contract; guarantees RNs the right to object to unsafe assignments and not to work outside the scope of their license; and creates a Registered Nurse Advisory Committee (RNAC) to meet once a month to enhance patient care: Article 8 – Patient Care and Advocacy and Professional Responsibility.

We won another important victory guaranteeing that RNs cannot be disciplined unfairly, with Article 10 – Corrective Action Process and Discipline.

We also achieved tentative agreements on Article 22 – Subcontracting and Article 27 – Entire Agreement.
