At this point in negotiations, we have made numerous proposals. However, despite twenty-three days since our last bargaining session, management returned to the table with responses to only three: Article 4 - Seniority, Article 16 - Holidays, and Article 29 - Bargaining Unit Work, which protects us from non-bargaining unit employees doing our work.

We reached tentative agreement on 16 and 29.

We also urged management to return to the next bargaining session prepared to make more substantial progress in the negotiations.

Connie Leyva, our California State Senator for Chino, has authored Senate Bill 227 to help enforce safe staffing ratios by requiring periodic unannounced inspections of hospitals to review ratio compliance.

Two members of our bargaining team, Sonia Chesterfield, RN, and Jennie Masaoy, RN, traveled to Sacramento in early April with other UNAC/UHCP members from hospitals throughout California to advocate for our patients and profession by telling legislators, including Leyva, their personal experiences to show the need for staffing ratio enforcement.
