Prem Reddy's Gift to You—Substandard Wages And No Respect: Happy Nurses Week!



After months of bargaining, management finally delivered a wage proposal that does nothing to address the recruitment and retention crisis at our medical center.

It includes a new hire grid that according to management reflects the current pay rates. Under this proposal, there would be no wage grid for current RNs with steps to reward experience.

The company's initial proposal on wages was far below what they just proposed the week before at Garden Grove to other UNAC/UHCP RNs. It's significantly less than what they have already agreed to in other RN union contracts.
