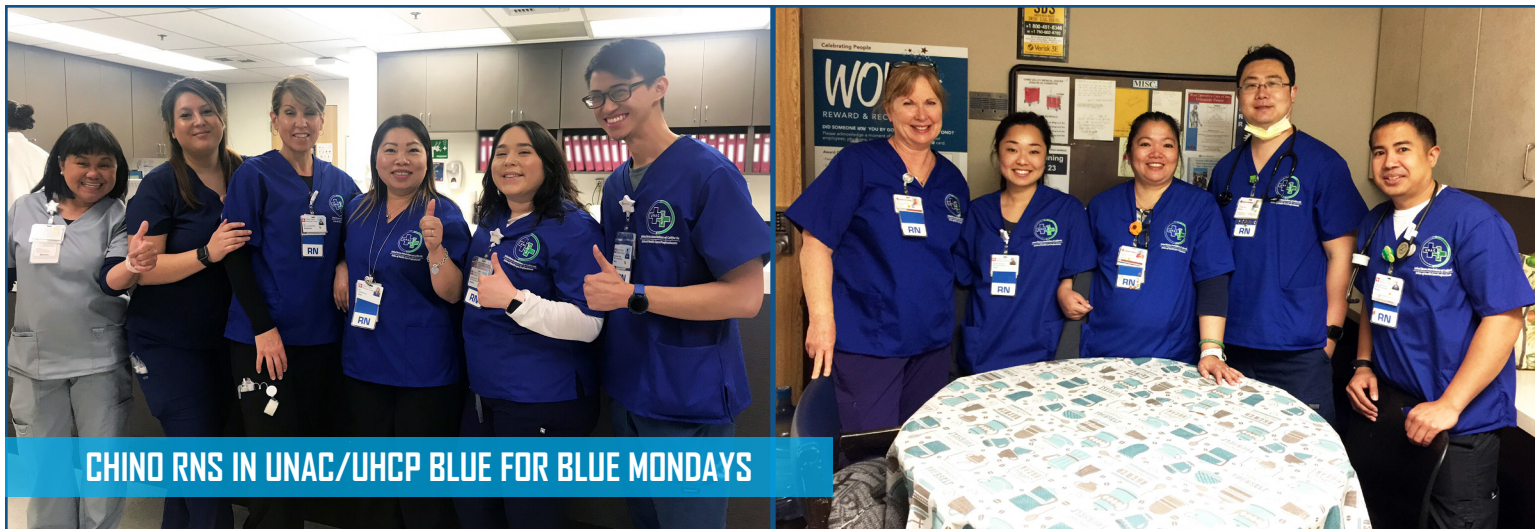

Patient Care & RN Safety Secured With New Floating Language

Today we won new floating language that will protect and improve patient care and nurse safety, in a Tentative Agreement (TA) on Article 12 – Floating:

- In our new contract, RNs may only be floated to a different department or unit after at least three days of orientation.
- Float assignments shall be equitably shared within departments or units.
- Newly-hired new grads shall not be floated until they've completed one year, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- Newly-hired experienced RNs shall not be floated until they've completed six months.
- Nurses who wish to float outside their float cluster can volunteer for cross-training with approval.

We also achieved a TA on Letter of Agreement #2 – Weekend On-Call Scheduling for GI / Surgical Services.
