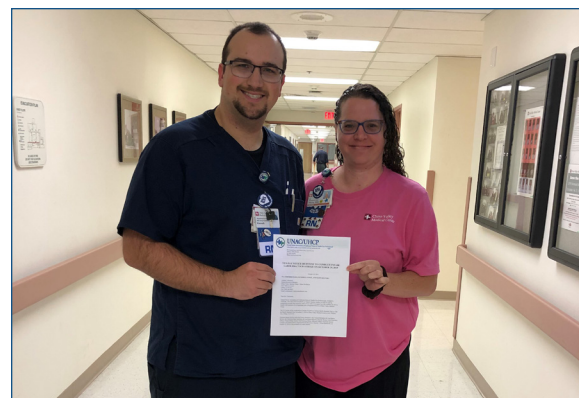

## STRIKE NOTICE: DELIVERED

Chino RNs are united, standing together for our patients and profession.

Today, we delivered our ten-day notice for a ULP (unfair labor practice) strike that will begin on October 29 at 7 am. It will conclude on Friday, November 1, when we will return to work at 7 am.

We have filed unfair labor practice charges with the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) for surveillance of Chino RNs by management; and attempts to prevent Chino RNs from engaging in protected, concerted activity.
