RN UNITY WON A STRONG TENTATIVE AGREEMENT

We have reached Tentative Agreement (TA) on a new three-year contract for the registered nurses at Garden Grove Hospital and Medical Center.

This agreement is a direct result of our collective action and unity. We came to bargaining. We wore stickers and UNAC/UHCP blue. We signed petitions and gathered to deliver them to management. We marched with our sisters and brothers at Chino Valley Medical Center in their informational picket. Then we planned our own informational picket for next week at Garden Grove. All of these actions were felt by management and influenced them at the bargaining table.

Our bargaining team recommends that members vote yes to ratify this agreement.

Improvements to our contract include:

- Strong wage increases
- Health benefits protected
- Enhanced educational benefits

GGRNA members will have a chance to get details on the entire agreement and have questions answered before casting your vote at ratification meetings to be held next Monday, October 21.
