Yesterday, our PRNA bargaining team presented a slate of 16 non-economic proposals that cut to the heart of ensuring a respectful and safe working environment, making scheduling fair, and showing value to our nurses at Parkview.

Proposals we put on the table included:

- Job security: Strong successorship language to safeguard the new contract in the event of transfer, sale or closure
- Work/Life Balance: Stronger language on cancellations, float policies and use of travelers
- Staff, patient safety: New commitments to a bullying-free workplace and collaboration on a blame-free Just Culture
