## UNAC/UHCP KEEPS WORKING FOR YOU: TEAM ADDS KEY SUCCESSORSHIP PROTECTION

**Corona, CA**—The UNAC/UHCP-PRNA bargaining team reached tentative agreements to improve the grievance and arbitration process and include strong successorship language to protect our future at Parkview. Bargaining continued at a steady pace on Monday, Nov. 19. Charmaine Morales, RN, UNAC/UHCP executive vice president, stopped by to support our team's efforts.

The successor language was a key win: Successor agreements give added protection to our legally enforceable contract. In the event of a sale, merger, consolidation, or other transfer, the new language can reduce any uncertainty about the buyer's and the seller's obligations to the union.

Your PRNA Bargaining team also met privately with AHMC Healthcare executives to discuss the Parkview sale. The discussion was informative and the team shared RN concerns regarding recruitment and retention of registered nurses. We also discussed bringing Parkview up to community standards. We stressed that our nurses and front line staff are committed to Parkview and view this facility as a family. We want Parkview to grow and succeed for the community and the Parkview staff. We look forward to working collaboratively with AHMC to make that happen.
