MHS Proposes 0% First Year Raise

Our UNHCEH bargaining team and management are still far apart on wages after bargaining for four days in January.

MHS Refuses to Budge

Management remains stuck on two proposals they have presented to us three times:

1.0% First Year Increase

Management's last proposal for across-the-board (ATB) raises: 0% in year one, 1.25% in year two, 1.25% in year three.

2. Bad Wage Grid
